

FOCUS OF Stewardship 2019

Increased gifts and offerings will be used to help the following:

GROWING LIVES

By investing in the lives of the individuals within our community and strengthening the on-going ministries, we provide a foundation for growth through contribution. With the continued support of the Kaye Prox Food Bank and The Portico homeless ministry through expansion and the funding of future needs, we provide the opportunity to positively effect change



for others. By being proactive, we can forecast additional needs that might present itself within our community; therefore, it is recommended that we work together to visit local schools and determine how we might further assist the students. For instance, we may find that the students need food over the weekend or clothing to wear to school; their needs are vast, and we have the humbling ability to pull resources together to help. It is proposed that a special team will further define how to best serve the interests of the community, through contribution, and present a plan to council for approval. Our goal is to impact an additional average of 300 lives through this initiative which will increase our current outreach by 56%. Presently, the targeted amount of funds needed to fulfill our goal is **\$7,500**.

COMMUNICATING LIFE

Lutheran Church of Our Saviour has a genuine opportunity to reach our homebound members and traveling members by touching the lives in our community by broadcasting live feeds of portions of our services. This is truly an exciting, new ministry opportunity for our church and our community; it has a proven record of success for fellow ministries. Additionally, we will continue our effort to invite and share the life of our church community here, at Lutheran Church of

Our Saviour, through our website and targeted social media communications. It is intended that we continue to grow our on-line reach and post-engagement exponentially as we increase our social media following. Our current Facebook following is 305 and the goal is to develop a strong support of 1,000 followers by the end of 2019. Within the next year, we would like to envision a post-engagement level that is reaching 36,000 individuals locally. We all will benefit to practice to be evangelistic by sharing the word with your friends and family. The current target goal to further support the endeavor is \$7,500.

MAINTAINING LIFE


